## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

First, I'll start with news of the synagogue. The monthly calendars for the year have been posted to the web site. We have finally picked August 27<sup>th</sup> as the date for the Pool Party at Levi's House. We are looking forward to having a fun day in the sun as we look forward to cooler weather and the High Holidays.

This last week I was in Crystal City attending the 2017 Men's Club Convention. This year's convention was done in conjunction with the Women's League and the Men of Reformed Judaism (MRJ). It was an interesting week. During the Israeli Embassy visit, the following groups participated in an official protest to the Israeli government's decision to not allow women to pray at the Western Wall as well as other transgressions against the progressive gains of American Judaism. The protest was recorded by numerous publications and is currently an on-going and evolving story.

All-in-all, the convention was the best by far that I have attended. The keynote speaker this year was Barney Frank who discussed not only some of the Washingtonian issues that he encountered but also related Jewish and Israeli issues into the context of his discussions. Overall, the hotel staff was friendly, the food was good and the Cantors' Concert was great. The conference saw two transitions. One was the transfer of the International President from Alan Gottesman to Stan Greenspan. While I just met Stan, Alan was approachable, friendly, and dynamic. The Bar Mitzvah JoAnn and I attended in May was at his synagogue. The other transition was at the Executive Director position. Rabbi Charles Simon retired after thirty-plus years of service to the FJMC, and Rabbi Andy Shugerman was introduced as his replacement. The ceremonies for the last two days of the conference, including the Cantors' Concert was dedicated to the accomplishments and achievements of Rabbi Simon related to building regional bridges within the continental US, expanding the FJMC presence to South America, Europe, and Israel, and instituting programs to improve Men's Clubs' posture within their own synagogues. The Cantors' Concert featured the tenor voice of Hazzan Alberto Mizrahi; he was accompanied by Hazzan Alisa Pomerantz-Boro, Hazzan Joanna Dulkan, Hazzan Steven Stoehr and Hazzan Ben Tisser. The cultural music and jocularly of this event is one of the highlights of every convention; unfortunately, Steven Stoehr indicated this was his last convention; he will be sorely missed.

My own activities at the convention focused on a couple of days of sightseeing for myself, picking up our Men's Club Quality Award for the year, chaperoning a tour group to the Air and Space Museum, a couple of Keruv events, a musical Friday night service, a meditative Shabbat, and participating in the nascent stages of an FJMC e-Magazine.

The Seaboard Region is planning their biennial retreat at the Capitol Camps June 8-10, 2018. Please consider attending as this is a welcome weekend with kosher food, good comradeship, and spiritual relaxation.

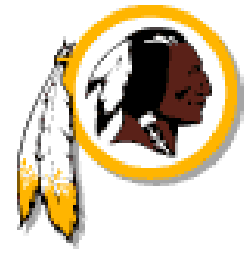

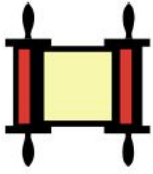

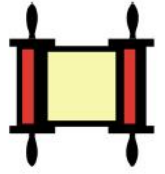
